IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING FUTURE LTRC SOLICATIONS Please be advised:

Effective September 1, 2023, LA DOTD's Louisiana Transportation Research Center (LTRC) will solicit Requests for Proposals (RFP) through this current method/email as well as through MyDOTD.

Beginning on January 1, 2025, LTRC will ONLY utilize MyDOTD for these solicitations. Please see below instructions to sign up.

- MyDOTD is a communications service that is located on the DOTD website in the top right hand corner by selecting the <u>MYDOTD</u> tab.
- Anyone can click on MYDOTD and enter into the portal where there is a <u>training link</u> (which offers sign up step by step instructions) and a map of the state that outlines the district and the parishes.
- You can click on any parish to be brought the parish page. Each parish page lists the most recent press releases, road and lane statuses, and public meeting announcements, as well as twitter page links, a link to 511 and a link to active projects in the parish.

Once you have signed up, in order to receive LTRC's RFP's, you will need to select "*CCS Advertisements*" under "*Release Type(s)*".

You can also elect to receive other notifications including road/lane closures, public meetings, press releases, information by project, region or parish, route, etc.
